- The races are held under the current UIM rules and homologations.

- All registrations will be confirmed by the organizer. If a competitor does not receive such confirmation, they are responsible to contact the organizer to verify their registration.
- Parents/Guardian name, signature and contact information on entry form is mandatory for all participants that are under 18 years age.

# 7. DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION AND SCRUTINEERING

Original documents must be presented and copies handed over to the Race Office.

- Original National Authority signed ratification document (UIM rule 203.01)
- Measurement certificate and racing license.
- Immersion test certificate for classes with safety cockpits.
- Documents of medical examination
- Insurance documents in English or in local official language (see more detailed explanation further in this document).
- Signed Acknowledgement of the anti-doping rules (can be signed at registration).
- All drivers must present their valid personal international accident Insurance Policy. If the Insurance are included on some National Authorities Racing Licenses, they must be drawn up in English.
- For times of scrutineering see Time Schedule.
- During the scrutineering all elements required by the UIM Rules will be checked.
- If driver is refused entry by technical scrutineers, the decision and reason must be clearly stated with applicable rule number(s), signed by technical scrutineers, OOD and UIM Sports Commissioner and will be posted on the official notice board at least one hour before the first driver's briefing to allow a protest or correction (New circuit Art. Rule 209).





- Practice will be allowed only after a successful technical inspection of the boat on the course at it will be laid out for the races. Practice will be allowed only during the official practice sessions as listed in the final time schedule of the event. The race course area will be closed for practice during any other time and any boat on the course during this time will be subject to disqualification from the event.

## 8. RACING COURSE AND LENGHTS

- Maximum number of boats on the race course: **18**
- Lengths and number of laps: U.I.M. rule 2.4.6
- Racing Course: see map in the end of this document
- Safety lap after checkered flag is obligatory. Not fulfilling this requirement results with disqualification.

## 9. RACING FORMAT AND STARTS

- F2 race format will be according to U.I.M. rules in the blue pages.
- The start will be dead engine start from a jetty as per U.I.M. Rules White and Blue pages.
- The start will be signaled with lights.
- On the start jetty each driver can be accompanied by not more than 3 (three)mechanics.
- It's the driver's responsibility to place the boat on the start in time. Late starters can only join the field by following the instructions of the Pontoon Marshall.
- Boats which do not line up with the boat next to them with 20 (twenty) seconds of being requested to do, it will be financially penalized −150,00€.
- After the first driver completes the race distance, each boat driven by the power of its own engine and having completed, at last, 70% of the laps of the winning boat will be classified as finisher.

## 11. FUEL

- According to U.I.M. rule 508
- Fuel: **95 Octane**

- The cost per litter will be the prevailing price in Portugal during the days of the event.
- Technical Commission will take fuel sample for inspection from the same petrol station.
- Refueling is forbidden in the launching area as well as at the starting jetty.
- Teams are not allowed to use their own fuel bought from others fuel stations.

# 12. TRANSPORT FACILITIES AND CONCESSIONS TRAVEL AND PRIZE MONEY

- No compensation for travel costs or for starting in the race will be paid.
- Prize Money As per U.I.M. F2 rule

## 13. PRIZES

- The three top drivers will be awarded with trophies.
- All drivers and teams must attend the Prize giving ceremony as per the time schedule.
- Everyone must attend the prize giving ceremony in their team's full uniform.
- The top three finishers must have to be present on the podium. If they are not present, a penalty of  $1.000,00 \in$  will be applied.





### 14. OTHER MANDATORY REGULATIONS

- The penalty for dislodging or damaging a buoy is 200€. The penalty shall be paid immediately at the race office. Should the responsible driver fail to pay the penalty fee, she/he is prohibited from participating the following events of the schedule. Once payment is made the driver is allowed to rejoin the events of the schedule.
- Obligatory Drivers briefing will be held according to the Time Schedule and will be organized in the pit area (see race course map).
- The organizer reserves rights for advertisements on the boats as regulated in UIM Rules 203.051.
- Any protest must be submitted to the Race Secretary in English according to UIM rule 403. The protest fee is 150€ payable in cash at the time of lodging the protest.
- Every driver is responsible that his engine does not exceed noise levels at all times as specified in U.I.M. Rule 505.
- Every driver is responsible to take care of the environment an absorbent carpet to avoid any spillage to the ground must be used according the UIM Rule 703.
- Organizer will make Letter of Invitation for Visa supply for participants if necessary.
- Results will be operatively published at race web-page (tobeindicated).

## 15. INSURANCE REGULATIONS

- All drivers are responsible for their own personal accident insurance valid in the European Union.
- Third-party liability insurance, which amounts to 100.000,000 is required.
- Insurance cover can be provided by Consulbrokers, partner of the UIM, for drivers and organisers: <a href="https://insurance.uim.sport/">https://insurance.uim.sport/</a>





If you have your own insurance to cover this amount then a copy of your policy, written in clear English, must be produced at registration. You can purchase local third-party insurance at a cost of  $90 \in \text{provided}$  by local organiser. The local third-party insurance has a capital coverage of  $100.000,00 \in$ , as required by the law in Portugal.

## 17. ORGANIZER ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS

#### **17.1. PIT AREA**

- The PIT Area must be closed, secured and restricted territory available to the technical staff of the teams, drivers and their equipment <u>only</u>. All technical preparation of the boats and their launch into the water shall be informed at the PIT Area.
- Any open fire or smoking shall be strictly prohibited in the PIT Area.
- Every boat in the PIT area shall have a fire extinguisher located in close vicinity of the boat.
- No animals shall be allowed in the PITArea.
- The PIT Area will be guarded from 12<sup>th</sup> until 14<sup>th</sup> September 2025 | 24.00h
- PIT Area will be closed during night hours from 22h00 to 7h00 and nobody without permission from race officials shall be allowed there.
- PIT Area passes and Pontoon Passes shall be provided by the organizers at the time of the arrival of the teams. Each team is responsible for indicating the number of necessary PIT Area passes at the time of application and registration.
- All team staff and drivers must wear appropriate team clothing and closed to shoes at the PIT Area <u>all</u>times.
- Any further rules and requirements relating to the PIT Area and its use shall be provided to the teams at registration and/or driver's meetings and posted on the designated board in PITArea.
- Any violation in the PIT Area shall be subject to a fine. Teams shall be informed about the applicable fines at the time of registration and posted on the designated board in the PIT Area. The Pits Officer shall bear sole responsibility for ensuring compliance with rules in the PIT Area.
- Due to restricted space at the PIT Area, <u>all</u> vehicles and trailers must be parked at the parking area, which will be signalized at the arrival.

  It's not allowed to keep trailers, trucks or cars at the PIT Area, unless truck or trailer is made as service equipment and it's necessary to fix to the pit canopy. In case of failure of this rule, sanctions will be applied accordingly.





#### 17.2. LAUNCH OF BOATS INTO THEWATER

- Launch of the boats into the water shall be performed with cranes in specially marked places only. Slipway is NOT available in that area.
- Instructions of the crane operators must be observed at all times during the launch of the boat into the water. Equipment must comply with the U.I.M. rules (205.12).
- Crane drivers have to be present all the time and only in permission of the Pontoon Marshall they are allowed to leave their positions.

#### 17.4. OTHER REGULATIONS

- The Organizer reserves the right to make any changes and regulations given in this advance-programme. All changes will be published in writing and announced during the driver's briefing.
- The Organizer invites the participants to use their national flags and team uniforms.
- By signing the entry form, each participant accepts the rules and regulations of this advance program, organizer instructions and U.I.M. rules.
- Drivers and Mechanics should follow the rule n.º 205.02.02 of the U.I.M. Rule Book concerning alcohol and drugs.
- During the event each boat must be prepared for the weighing procedure, which shall be carried out by the technical committee at any requested time. The weighing of the boats cannot be protested.





- The Organizers <u>will not</u>, in any way, have responsibility towards the drivers, mechanics, or other participants of the event for any material damages incurred during or in connection with the event. Boat drivers and other participants acknowledge that they are fully aware of the risks associated with participation in the races and shall take part in the races at their own risk.
- The Local Organizer provides stickers of Local Sponsors of the event. These stickers are <u>mandatory</u> stickers from the Local Organizer and should be attached onto both sponsors of each participating boat (202.02.24). Each sticker should have a maximum of 30x10cm.
- The organizer reserves the right to add advertising according to U.I.M.
- The Organizer recommends teams and their representatives to not interfere with local sponsors of the event.
- Every participant authorizes the organizers, the partners and the media to use, free of charge, the images taken on the occasion of his participation in the World Championship Race on whom he/she could appear on any supports, including the promotional or advertising documents.


